

UPDATED DISCRETIONARY FINDING POLICY FOR NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATIONS

- Applicability: This policy applies to all Not-for-Profit organizations except public safety organizations providing law enforcement, fire and emergency medical services.
- Discretionary Funding is a duly appropriated sum of money in the Towns expense budget allocated by the Council to an eligible not-for-profit
 organization for or in support of a public purpose.
- Public Purpose: All discretionary funds are only for a public purpose and may not support political activities and/or private interests.
- Applications: All organizations wishing to receive discretionary funding from the Town must submit a written application to the Town Clerk containing the information described below:
 - A detailed scope of services to be delivered or performed
 - Budget for the services to be provided
 - Copy most Recent IRS-990 or proof of not-for-profit status
 - In lieu of IRS-990 a financial statement showing all sources of income
 - Chief Executive Officer (CEO)
 - Chief Financial Officer (CFO)
 - Board of Directors List or Equivalent
 - Previous/Existing Contract information
 - Additional Information may be required in the discretion of the Town Council
- The Town Council reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to decrease or rescind funding at any time by notice in writing


