Local Law No. ____ of 2022

Local Law of the Town of Greenwich repealing Local Law 1 of 2022, Cannabis Opt-Out, pursuant to Cannabis Law §131.

Section 1. Legislative Intent:

It is the intent of this Local Law to repeal Local Law 1 of 2022 in its entirety, whereby opting back in to permitting the licensing and establishing retail cannabis dispensaries and on-site cannabis consumption establishments within the jurisdiction of the Town of Greenwich, outside of the Village of Greenwich.

Section 2. Authority:

This local law is adopted pursuant to the authority vested in the Town Board of the Town of Greenwich pursuant to Municipal Home Rule Law §10 of the State of New York.

Section 3. Repeal.

Local Law 1 of 2022 of the Town of Greenwich, adopted on December 14, 2021, resolution No. 126-21, and filed in the office of the New York Secretary of State on April 1, 2022, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 4. Severability:

If a court determines any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or the application thereof to any person, firm or corporation, or circumstance is invalid or unconstitutional, the court's order or judgement shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder of this local law, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or in its application to the person, individual, firm or corporation or circumstance, directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment or order shall be rendered.

Section 5. Effective Date:

This Local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Office of the New York Secretary of State.

Local Law No. ____ of 2022

Local Law of the Town of Greenwich partially repealing Local Law 1 of 2022, Cannabis Opt-Out, pursuant to Cannabis Law §131.

Section 1. Legislative Intent:

It is the intent of this Local Law to partially repeal Local Law 1 of 2022 by repealing that section of Local Law 1 of 2022 by which the Town of Greenwich opted out of licensing and establishing retail cannabis dispensaries within the jurisdiction of the Town of Greenwich, outside of the Village of Greenwich, whereby opting back in to permitting the licensing and establishing retail cannabis dispensaries within the jurisdiction of the Town of Greenwich, outside of the Village of Greenwich.

Section 2. Authority:

This local law is adopted pursuant to the authority vested in the Town Board of the Town of Greenwich pursuant to Municipal Home Rule Law §10 of the State of New York.

Section 3. Repeal.

After partial repeal, Local Law 1 of 2022 shall read as follows:

The Town Board of the Town of Greenwich, County of Washington, hereby opts-out of allowing on-site cannabis consumption establishments from locating and operating within the jurisdiction of the Town of Greenwich, outside the Village of Greenwich, and hereby requests that the Cannabis Control Board prohibit the establishment of such on-site consumption licenses within the jurisdiction of the Town of Greenwich, outside the Village of Greenwich.

Section 4. Severability:

If a court determines any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or the application thereof to any person, firm or corporation, or circumstance is invalid or unconstitutional, the court's order or judgement shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder of this local law, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or in its application to the person, individual, firm or corporation or circumstance, directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment or order shall be rendered.

Section 5. Effective Date:

This Local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Office of the New York Secretary of State.
