Hudson River Park Update

Roof replacement, bathroom conversion to ADA compliance, and installation of a new security door will start in the next week or so. All work is to be completed by the middle of August or sooner.

Battenkill Riverside Park

Secure paper towel and toilet paper holders have been installed in the bathrooms. Sand for the volleyball court and mulch for the playground are being ordered for the park. A new volleyball net has also been purchased and will be installed. Fencing for the shoreline is on hand and will be installed. Thank you to Joanna Messina and Town Board Parks Committee members Jim Mumby and Tom Grave for all their work maintaining the park.

Consolidated Funding Grants

Requests for proposals for Consolidated Funding grants as well as other opportunities for funding are available for 2023. I am working with LaBella Engineering and the Village Mayor to develop a preliminary list of possible and feasible projects the Town Board can consider for funding applications.

Summer Youth Program

Defibrillator Purchase

We ordered the defibrillator machines on February 16. Unfortunately, there is a 5 to 6-month backlog. Therefore, we should receive the machines in the next month or two and training can start.

Comprehensive Plan

A public input event was held at HRP. This was followed by soliciting public input via the Town's website. Our partner's, LaBella Engineering, are working to consolidate and synthesize public input in preparation for the next comprehensive Plan meeting.
